1. **Permission for Access and Monitoring:** I agree to allow CasinoGreen staff or subcontractors to access my facility to evaluate possible energy efficiency measures. I realize that this may require CasinoGreen staff or subcontractors to extend ladders and to open fixtures and service hatches throughout the property, and to temporarily install and subsequently remove energy monitoring equipment (if any) needed to establish baseline energy use and system performance.

2. **Energy Monitoring Equipment:** I understand that I have no ownership, interest or title in energy monitoring equipment (if any) that may be temporarily installed for the purposes of this evaluation; and I further understand that CasinoGreen staff or subcontractors will bear all of the actual costs associated with installing, monitoring, and removing said equipment.

3. **Confidentiality:** I understand that any items designated below as sensitive or confidential will remain so within CasinoGreen, Pacific Gas & Electric Company, and the California Public Utilities Commission.

4. **Liability:** I understand Ecology Action is receiving funds from PG&E for the CasinoGreen Program, but both Parties, including myself, the Customer and Ecology Action, the Implementer, agree that PG&E is not liable to either Party for any losses or damages, including incidental or consequential damages, arising from this Agreement.

5. **I understand that receiving an evaluation does not obligate me in any way,** nor does it guarantee that Program benefits will be extended to my business.

PG&E Electric Rate Schedule

California consumers are not obligated to purchase any full-fee service or other service not funded by this program. The CasinoGreen Program is funded by California ratepayers under the auspices of the California Public Utilities Commission.

Eligibility

CasinoGreen targets Native American-owned casinos and related facilities throughout PG&E territory. These establishments host retail, gaming, food service, entertainment and lodging operations. There are 30 tribal casinos in PG&E's service area; all 30 are eligible to receive Program services. Gaming and related facilities that are not Native American-owned and all such facilities located outside PG&E territory are not eligible.

Process

1. Qualifying businesses receive a free energy audit and report detailing recommended energy-saving measures, expected installation costs, estimated energy savings and rebate amount.
2. When the Customer has reviewed the report and decided to implement the CasinoGreen recommendations, the Program will make pre-screened contractors available to perform the work at a time that is convenient to the Customer.
3. Finally, CasinoGreen will perform a follow-up inspection to confirm the quality of installation. After a successful installation, the Customer is responsible to the contractor(s) for the portion of installation costs not covered by the rebate, if any.

Restrictions

This Program is available from January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2012 or until Program funds have been allocated. All installations must be completed and inspected and rebates paid by November 30, 2012 to qualify. Funds will be distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis.
